SUBJECT: CORRECTION OF NUMBERING AND FORMAT ERRORS - THREE MILE ISLAND STATION, UNIT 2 – ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT NO. 68, HISTORIC AND CULTURAL RESOURCES (L-2023-LLA-0026)

Dear Mr. Richardson:

On August 9, 2024 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML24135A327 (pkg.)), the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Amendment No. 68 to Possession Only License (POL) No. DPR-73 for the Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit No. 2 (TMI-2). The amendment allows TMI-2 Solutions to conduct certain decommissioning activities at TMI-2 that were not previously addressed in the staff's environmental reviews (site-specific impacts to historic and cultural resources).

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that there were administrative errors in the section numbering, page numbering, and formatting in the license. Specifically, the last page of the license was incorrectly formatted. The last section was incorrectly identified as Section D as opposed to Section 3. Also, the last sentence on page 3 of the license was move to page 4 and therefore page 3 did not correctly show this change. The license was corrected and signed by the authorizing official with these changes. Enclosed, please find the corrected license.

It can be demonstrated that the errors were introduced inadvertently in License Amendment No. 68, to POL No. DPR-73 were not requested by the licensee in its application, and that the erroneous changes were not addressed in the notice to the public nor reviewed by the NRC staff. Under these circumstances, the changes that introduced the administrative errors in the section numbering and page numbering were not proper amendments to the license because they were neither addressed in the notices nor reviewed, and correction of these errors are not a "change" to the staff's determination of no significant hazards or conclusions in its Safety Evaluation. The changes introduced by the errors were in fact improperly made.

Accordingly, consistent with guidance ([ML103260096](#)) and Staff Requirements Memorandum dated December 17, 1996 ([ML003754054](#)), the administrative errors are corrected by this letter, instead of an amendment to the license and are effective immediately.

In accordance with 10 CFR Section 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding," of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's Agencywide Documents Access
