
Mr. Lorson:

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that Weirton Medical Center, Inc. ("Weirton Medical Center") is finalizing the terms of an Agreement and Plan of Affiliation pursuant to which West Virginia United Health System, Inc. d/b/a West Virginia University Health System ("WVUHS") will become the sole corporate member of Weirton Medical Center on or about January 1, 2025 (the "Transaction"). In accordance with 10 C.F.R. §§ 30.34 and 70.36, Weirton Medical Center requests the consent of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") to the indirect change of control of Materials License No. 47-17567-01 resulting from the Transaction.

Enclosed with this letter is the Information Needed for Transfer of Control Application. Following the Transaction, Weirton Medical Center will continue operation under the same name, and there will be no changes to the licensee, personnel, use, or location of the devices. ("Weirton Medical Center") and West Virginia United Health System, Inc. d/b/a West Virginia University Health System ("WVUHS") are finalizing the terms of an Agreement and Plan of Affiliation pursuant to which WVUHS will become the sole corporate member of Weirton Medical Center (the "Transaction"). The anticipated closing date of the Transaction will occur on or before December 31, 2024, with an effective time of 12:00:01 a.m. on January 1, 2025. Prior to closing of the Transaction, Weirton Medical Center is required to obtain approval by the NRC for the indirect change of control in the licensed nuclear material.

The name of the Transferor is: Weirton Medical Center, Inc.

The name of the Transferee is:
West Virginia United Health System, Inc. d/b/a West Virginia University Health System

The parties note that WVUHS is a “known entity” for purposes of nuclear materials licensing because it is the parent company to several other NRC medical licensees.¹

No changes to personnel. The Radiation Safety Officer for the activities authorized by this License will remain the same—Mark Perna, MS, DABR. See attached Weirton Medical Center NRC License.

There will be no changes in location, facilities, equipment, or procedures that relate to the licensed program. There will be no changes in the name of the licensee. The only change is the corporate member of the licensee.

4. Describe the status of the licensee’s facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program, including any known contamination and whether decontamination will occur prior to transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.

Licensee’s facilities continue to be operated in accordance with the terms of the license and the licensed program. There is no known contamination and so no decontamination is needed prior to transfer. All calibrations, tests, surveys, training, quality control, and recordkeeping is up-to-date and compliant, and all such records will transfer to Transferee in the course of the transaction. 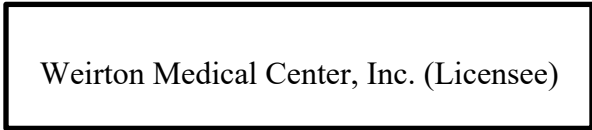

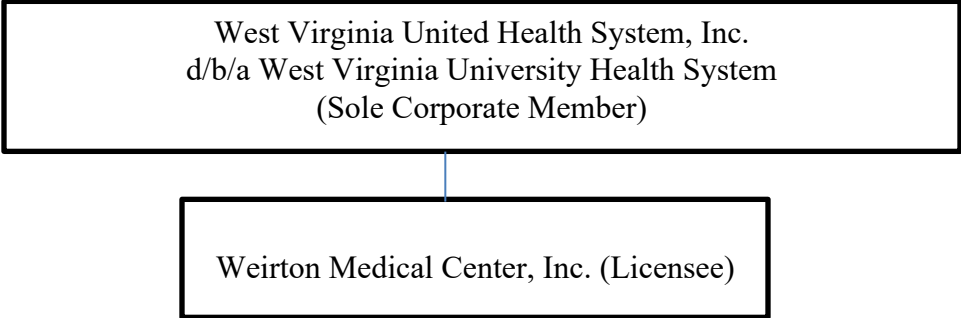

Pre-Transaction Organizational Structure



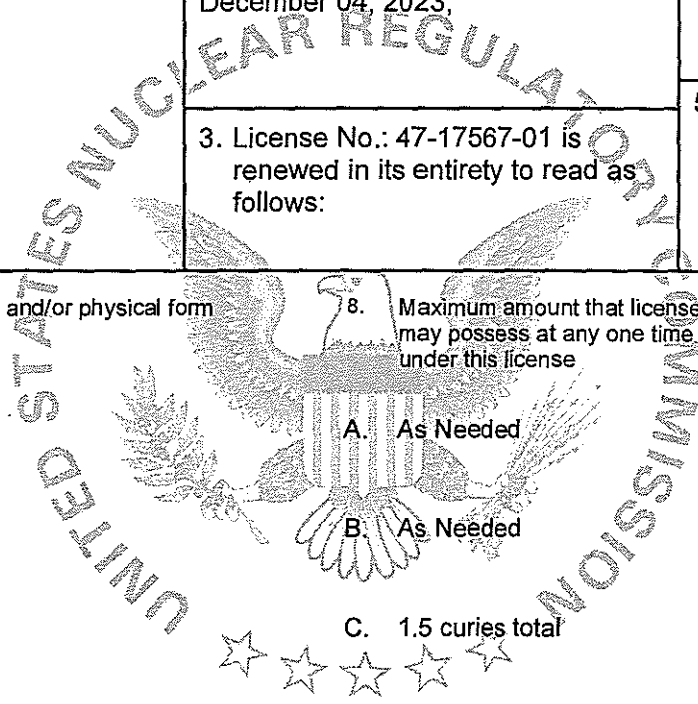
Post-Transaction Organizational Structure

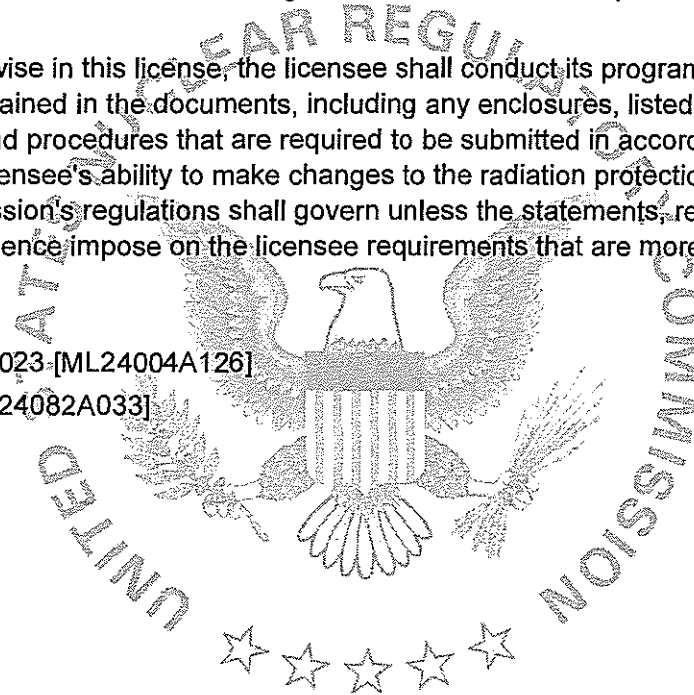
