**Definitions:**

**Control:** Control of a license is in the hands of the person or persons who are empowered to decide when and how that license will be used. That control is to be found in the person or persons who, because of ownership or authority explicitly delegated by the owners, possess the power to determine corporate policy and, thus, the direction of the activities under the license.

**Transferee:** A transferee is an entity that proposes to purchase or otherwise gain control of an NRC-licensed operation.

**Transferor:** A transferor is an NRC licensee selling or otherwise giving up control of a licensed operation.

**Information Needed for Transfer of Control**

Licensees must provide full information and obtain NRC's **prior written consent** before transferring control of the license. **Response:**

- On March 5, 2024, Aldinger acquired all of the issued and outstanding stock of Cal-Cert, which resulted in a change of control of Cal-Cert (the "Transaction"). However,

based on discussions with the NRC, in the Transaction documentation pursuant to which the change of control occurred, Aldinger agreed not to exercise or exert any control over, or otherwise use or operate under, the Materials License until the requisite approval is obtained from the NRC in connection with the proposed transfer.

- Because Cal-Cert remains a standalone entity, wholly-owned by Aldinger, and its operations remain the same now as they were prior to the Transaction, Cal-Cert will remain the entity that holds and operates under the current Materials License, so no actual transfer of the holder of the Materials License is being requested or intended to occur. Also, the Cal-Cert employees that have historically performed the nuclear gauge calibrations under the Materials License, including Anthony Lewandowski, the National Service Manager/RSO, who is responsible for the Materials License, are still employees of Cal-Cert, now under the ownership of Aldinger, and will continue to perform the nuclear gauge calibrations for Cal-Cert if this application is approved. The records, systems, and procedures, including the ISO/IEC 17025 accreditation remain in place.
- Prior to the Transaction, Marshall L. Doyle owned 100% of the issued stock in Cal-Cert and was Cal-Cert's sole director, president, and secretary. Following the close of the Transaction, Aldinger became the sole shareholder. Currently, the officers and directors of Cal-Cert are as follows:

2. Describe any changes in personnel or duties that relate to the licensed program. Include training and experience for new personnel and any changes in the training program.

**Response:**

- No changes have been made.

3. Describe any changes in the location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program.

**Response:**

- No changes have been made.

4. Describe the status of the licensee's facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program, including any known contamination and whether decontamination will occur prior to transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.

**Response:**

- No changes have been made to Cal-Cert's facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program. Cal-Cert uses a specially designed trailer containing the following equipment:
    - A survey meter for area surveys and contamination surveys;
    - A dosimeter, a personal monitoring device which is worn by the authorized Cal-Cert service representative; and
    - A Lead Pig, a lead containment device used to shield the sealed source rod when removal from the Nuclear Density Gauge is required.
  - No known contamination has occurred.
  - There are no changes to the status of calibration, training, quality control or related records.
  - Cal-Cert is not required to perform leak tests, area surveys or wipe tests as Cal-Cert does not possess nuclear density gauges.
5. If current decommissioning funding plans (DFP) will be changed as a result of the transfer, the revised DFP should be submitted. If other financial assurance documents will be changed as a result of the transfer, confirm that all financial assurance instruments associated with the license will be held in the transferee's name before the license is transferred, and as required by 10 CFR 30.35(f), the licensee must, within 30 days, submit financial instruments reflecting such changes.

**Response:**

- No changes have been made.

6. Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.

**Response:**

- Since the Transaction was only a change in ownership of Cal-Cert, the licensee, records did not need to be transferred, as they remain in the possession and control of Cal-Cert, now under Aldinger's ownership.

7. Confirm that both transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer, and that the transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.

**Response:**

- Both Transferor and Transferee agree to the transferring of control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer. There are currently no open inspection items. However, the Transferee is aware of its responsibility for possible future enforcement actions that may be brought by the governing authority.

8. Confirm that the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.

**Response:**

- The Transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor. If, in the future, the Transferee desires to make changes to the current licensed program, the Transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program to the appropriate authority.

9. The transferee, in the case of fuel cycle facilities, shall provide documentation showing that it is financially qualified to conduct normal operations. The information can be in the form of income statements and balance sheet forecasts.

Dear Ms. Simmons:

In accordance with Section 184 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, and 10 CFR 30.34(b), Cal-Cert, Company, an Oregon corporation ("**Cal-Cert**"), and Aldinger Company, a Texas corporation ("**Aldinger**"), respectfully request that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("**NRC**") provide written consent for the transfer of control of NRC License No. 36-35713-01 (the "**Materials License**").

The Materials License has been used by Cal-Cert to perform nuclear gauge calibration. The gauges are used to determine the density of soil and asphalt compaction during construction. Cal-Cert performs the calibrations on-site at customer locations with the required radioactive materials equipment stored in a specially designed trailer. Employees wear a dosimeter to measure exposure and Cal-Cert maintains all records as required by applicable regulations. Cal-Cert's Technicians are factory trained and supported by the equipment manufacturer, Humboldt Scientific.

Aldinger is an accredited provider of calibration services for test and measurement equipment and has provided calibration services for over fifty years.

On March 5, 2024, Aldinger acquired all of the issued and outstanding stock of Cal-Cert (the “**Transaction**”), which resulted in a change of control of Cal-Cert and the Materials License. Prior to the Transaction, the parties notified the NRC that they the desired to transfer control of the Materials License to Aldinger and sought guidance from the NRC on how to proceed with the transfer. The NRC instructed the parties that the Transaction would not be deemed a transfer of control of the Materials license if the proposed transferee, Aldinger, agreed (i) not to exercise or exert any control over, or otherwise use or operate under, the Materials License until the requisite written consent was obtained; (ii) to include an NRC approved provision within the Transaction documentation stating the foregoing restriction; and (iii) to take the necessary steps to obtain the required written consent following the closing of the Transaction.

As instructed, an approved provision was included in the Transaction documentation and the parties proceeded to close the Transaction. The parties now submit this letter along with the enclosed Information Needed for Transfer of Control Application in their request for written consent of the transfer of control of the Materials License from Cal-Cert to Aldinger.
