On March 15, 2023, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approved the transfer of license for the La Crosse Boiling Water Reactor (LACBWR) from LaCrosseSolutions (LS) (Reference 1) to Dairyland Power Cooperative (DPC). In support of the license transfer, Revision 31 of the LACBWR Quality Assurance Program Description (QAPD) was submitted to the NRC on July 12, 2022 (Reference 2). The NRC provided no comment on revision 31 to the Quality Assurance Program. The QAPD satisfies the requirements of 10 CFR 50 Appendix B, 10 CFR71 Subpart H, and 10 CFR 72 Subpart G.

Dairyland Power Cooperative assumed responsibilities as the LACBWR licensee on March 15, 2023. Pursuant to 10 CFR 71.101 (f), this letter notifies the NRC of our intent to apply our previously approved Quality Assurance Program (LACBWR QAPD, Revision 31) to transportation activities.
