Hi John,

We can proceed with the review of the FMR Source Term Methodology White Paper if GA-EMS is ok with the NRC staff proposed hours and schedule. After assessing the report and feedback requested, we estimate the white paper review to be around 225 hours and 10.75 months. Due to the holidays the technical staff is out of the office; therefore, we plan to start the review on January 8, 2024, if GA-EMS wants us to proceed.
