Item 3.A:

Item 10 of License Condition 13.A in License No. 13-00951-02, amendment 115, committed the licensee to develop, implement, and maintain written procedures for the safe use of unsealed byproduct material. Section VI of the hospital policy No: RAD-NM-006-P "Radiology Nuclear Medicine and Nuclear Cardiology Dose Administration," dated March 29, 2022, required the licensee verify a patient's name, DOB, and exam type before administration. Contrary to the above, on September 20, 2022, the licensee identified they failed to verify a patient's name, DOB, and exam type, and administered 12 mCi of Tc-99 sestamibi to the wrong individual.
