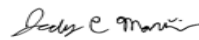

**Generic Environmental Impact Statement for Licensing of New Nuclear Reactors;
Correction; 10 CFR Part 51 [NRC-2020-0101; RIN 3150-AK55]**

On October 17, 2024, the Office of the Federal Register published a notice in the *Federal Register* (89 FR 83632) correcting two printing errors in a proposed rule document (2024-22385) that was published on October 4, 2024 (89 FR 80797).

List of Approved Spent Fuel Storage Casks: Holtec International HI-STORM 100 Cask System, Certificate of Compliance No. 1014, Renewed Amendment No. 18; Confirmation of Effective Date; 10 CFR Part 72 [NRC-2024-0105; RIN 3150-AL18]

On October 18, 2024, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) published a notice in the *Federal Register* (89 FR 83775) confirming the effective date of November 19, 2024, for the direct final rule that published in the *Federal Register* at 89 FR 72304 on September 5, 2024. The direct final rule amended its spent fuel storage regulations by revising the Holtec International HI-STORM 100 Cask System listing within the “List of approved spent fuel storage casks” to include Renewed Amendment No. 18 to Certificate of Compliance No. 1014. Renewed Amendment No. 18 amends the certificate of compliance to incorporate the Holtec Report No. HI-2200343-A entitled, “Topical Report for Allowance of Heat Load Patterns in HI-STORM 100 and HI-STORM FW Systems.” The effective date of November 19, 2024, for the direct final rule published on September 5, 2024, is confirmed.

MAGNASTOR® Storage System listing within the “List of approved spent fuel storage casks” to include Amendment No. 13 to Certificate of Compliance No. 1031. The effective date of November 19, 2024, for the direct final rule published on September 5, 2024, is confirmed.
