This is in reference to your application dated July 31, 2024, requesting to renew NRC License No. 47-18320-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information. Please be aware that, unless stated otherwise, all "Item", "Section", and "Appendix" references below are referring to NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Revision 3, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Medical Use Licenses" found at <https://www.nrc.gov/docs/ML1925/ML19256C219.pdf>.

1. Item 9, Facility Diagram and Other Equipment and Facilities - Your application did not provide all relevant information found in Section 8.9.1 of NUREG-1556, Vol. 9., Rev. 3. Please provide the following additional information:
 - a. Please provide a detailed diagram of your nuclear medicine room and hot lab, showing all areas where byproduct material is prepared, used, and stored.
 - b. Please provide room numbers and/or suite number, whichever is applicable, for the nuclear medicine room and hot lab.
 - c. On your facility diagram, doors should be indicated. Please specify which doors are access controlled (i.e., locked).
 - d. Please confirm that radioactive waste is not stored in the stress lab. Alternatively, please confirm that the stress lab is locked when not in use.
 - e. Please confirm that this building has only one floor (i.e., nothing above and below).
 - f. For Informational Purposes Only - Please note that drawings and diagrams that provide the exact location of materials or depict specific locations or safety or security equipment should be marked as **"Security Related Information - Withhold under 10 CFR 2.390."** No response to this item is required.
2. You submitted the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) Delegation of Authority. However, it was not signed by Mark T. Perna, M.S., DABR, your RSO.

Please provide a copy of your RSO Delegation of Authority that has been signed by both management and your RSO.
