Per your request, we are updating our financial administration and delegation authority information. According to our records, we initially submitted this information to Region III in an August 2, 1990, letter and updated it in an April 3, 1997, letter. The following information is the most current.

We submitted our statement of intent and cost estimate information in an April 8, 2003, letter. Colonel King, Chief of Staff of the US Army Joint Munitions Command, signed the statement of intent.

In accordance with Defense Finance and Accounting Services Regulation 37-1, Finance and Accounting Policy Implementation, chapter 3, January, 2000, the Commander has fund control responsibility and can delegate that authority. Within the US Army Joint Munitions Command, the Chief of Staff has the authority to sign as the principal agent of the Commanding General for the coordination and administration of the headquarters.
