## MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Oral Argument Logistics and Administrative Information)

Per the Board's October 29 and November 13, 2024 Orders, oral argument will be conducted in this proceeding on Tuesday, December, 3, 2024, beginning at 10:00 a.m. EST. While the Board is uncertain how long the argument will take, and the Board will endeavor to streamline the argument as much as possible, it is blocking until 3:00 p.m. EST and suggests that all participating counsel plan to accommodate no more than a 60-minute lunch period.

The oral argument will be conducted via a web conferencing platform. On or before noon EST on Tuesday, November 26, 2024, each of the NRC Staff, Powertech (USA) Inc., the Organizational Petitioners (Oglala Sioux Tribe, Black Hills Clean Water Alliance, and NDN Collective), and the Individual Petitioner (Susan Henderson) shall provide an email to the Board's law clerk, Ms. Dean (<a href="whitlee.dean@nrc.gov">whitlee.dean@nrc.gov</a>), identifying the name(s)¹ and email address(es) of the counsel who will be presenting on behalf of that participant, along with the counsel's preferred title (e.g., Mr., Mrs., Ms., etc.). Those identified counsel will be the only

participant representatives given video access to the argument.<sup>2</sup>

The oral argument's primary purpose is to allow the Board to ask questions and obtain answers concerning the admissibility of the petitioners' proffered contentions under 10 C.F.R. § 2.309. Because the argument is not an evidentiary hearing, the participants should not attempt to introduce evidence during the argument. Additionally, material not already cited in the relevant pleadings should not be used. Counsel should keep in mind that the Board has read the written pleadings. Counsel should not simply repeat arguments but focus on providing answers to the questions posed, with references to documents in the docket as necessary. In addition to other preparation, counsel should be prepared to discuss Crow Butte Resources, Inc. (Marsland Expansion Area), CLI-14-2, 79 N.R.C. 11 (2014).

Although the participants' counsel will be appearing remotely, all those taking part in the oral argument should conduct themselves as if in a hearing room setting, including seeking to minimize outside noise and interruptions while the argument is ongoing.

As a reminder, members of the public utilizing the listen-only telephone line will **not** be able to participate in the argument in any way, including by pressing \*5.
