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Section 53.610(a)(6)(ii) "Appropriate programmatic controls to provide special treatment for non-safety-related but safety-significant structures, systems, and components (SSCs).."

If I remember correctly, the standard practice in construction was/is to build the item according to the plans, drawings, codes, and standards (of the agreed-upon issue date). Either you met these requirements, or you didn't. If you did, that was good enough. If you didn't, you probably had to remove the non-compliant item and try again. (On a hard money job, you were paying for this second attempt, not the customer.)
