Good morning,

We really like having them. When there is a low battery an alert comes up on the app and we get the gauge in to replace that battery. We check the tracking at the time of calibration to verify its tracking as it should. Otherwise our primary mode of tracking gauges is still by way of our sign in sheet which is checked weekly by the manager. The tracker is a secondary form of tracking.

I'm also getting audits from our offices now each month to verify that they are maintaining the needed controls. Here's what I got from the Dexter office for November:

- Review of weekly sign in/out form
- Inventory of gauges in storage relative to sign in/out
- Review of all binders in cabinet to verify appropriate license and use of standard sheet
- Review of all Type A cases in-office to verify appropriate labeling
- Review of trucks in lot to verify appropriate locking
- Verification of records for sign in/out and weekly inventory
- Verbal verification with Ken & Dylan that managers weekly audit is being completed
- Verbal verification with Ken & Dylan that all gauges have trackers and batteries are being replaced upon low batter alert

Using these trackers does require regular replacement of batteries. If your team is recommending this to others, the licensee will need to be aware that they will need an attentive person monitoring who will need to replace batteries every 4-6 months.
