**SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE FOR NUCLEAR  
DIAGNOSIS, INC., NRC LICENSE NO. 24-17561-01**

Dear Jon Thoreson:

In letter dated September 30, 2024, Zachary Riggins, Chief Financial Officer for HCA/Nuclear Diagnosis, Inc., notified the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of a request to terminate NRC Materials License No. 24-17561-01. The letter is available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML24306A134 (non-public).

An environmental assessment for this action is not required because this action is categorically excluded under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) Section 51.22(c).

In the letters dated September 30, 2024 and December 24, 2024, you submitted information sufficient to permit the transfer of facilities at 500 Porter St., 500 Porter St, Missouri, 65605, 1150 State Hwy. 248, Branson, Missouri, 65616, 525 Branson Landing Blvd., Branson, Missouri, 65616, 1502 N Jefferson, Carrollton, Missouri, 64663, 94 Main, Cassville, Missouri, 65625, 1333 S Sam Houston Blvd., Houston, Missouri, 65483, and 751 Sappington Bridge Rd., Sullivan, Missouri, 63080, to another NRC licensee — Midwest Nuclear Services, LLC, NRC License No. 24-35770-01. Based on its review, the NRC staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material at the locations above has been transferred from Nuclear Diagnosis, Inc., NRC License No. 24-17561-01, to Midwest Nuclear Services, LLC, NRC License No. 24-35770-01.

Based on this conclusion, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC-regulated material are required on the part of Nuclear Diagnosis, Inc. The NRC understands that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facilities at the locations above have been transferred to and will be maintained by Midwest Nuclear Services, LLC, NRC License No. 24-35770-01.

Accordingly, NRC License No. 24-17561-01 is hereby terminated. A copy of the amended license—Amendment No. 86—is enclosed.
