Dear Jose' Carrera:

This is in reference to your letter dated January 17, 2025, requesting to amend NRC License No. 52-21175-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

- Section 8.7.1," Radiation Safety Officer Training and Experience," of NUREG-1556, Volume 6, Revision 1 (Vol.6, Rev.1), "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licensees – Program-Specific Guidance About 10 CFR Part 36 Irradiator Licensees," states that the named individual should agree, in writing, to assume the duties of the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). Appendix F of the above NUREG contains a Delegation of Authority for this purpose. Please complete and submit the Delegation of Authority for your proposed RSO.
- 2. Your letter states that the proposed RSO has completed the Gamma Irradiator Operator Training requirements. Please submit the documentation of this training for our review, include the number of hours and the topics covered.
- 3. Your letter states that the proposed RSO has completed On-the-Job Training under a certified RSO. License Condition 11 of NRC License No. 52-21175-01 requires, in part, that the licensee maintain records of individuals designated as users for three years following the last use of licensed material by the individual. Please submit a copy of the designation by an RSO that your proposed RSO meets the training requirements of License Condition 11.
- 4. Please note that the Commission does not list Alternate (Auxiliary) Radiation Safety Officers on the license. If an RSO should be unable to perform their duties for a short period of time, a qualified individual may act on their behalf for that period. The circumstances permitting the use of Auxiliary RSO are in NUREG-1556, Vol.6, Rev. 1, Section 8.7.1. The qualifications of the individual would be examined during the inspection process.
- 5. Our records indicate that Marco Torres-Delgado was the 10 CFR Part 37 Reviewing Official. Since they are no longer with the company, please indicate their replacement and their qualifications for being the Reviewing Official.

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6. Please provide contact information for your proposed RSO (email and phone number).
