PART I.D -- COMMENTS

We received your request on November 13, 2023. Your request noted that you believed the records to which you seek access were likely produced between November 7, 1974 and November 13, 1974, though they may not have been filed for several months. We tasked the Office of Investigations (OI) and Region IV (RIV) to search for any responsive records.

OI staff searched for records responsive to your request and found no records. RIV staff searched for records responsive to your request and found records.

In addition to the records that we have enclosed, RIV staff did find a package of 31 records from the 1970's that is already publicly available in the NRC's official recordkeeping repository, Agencywide Documents and Access Management System (ADAMS) in the Main Library (ML). The accession number for this package of records is ML23297A078 which you may access through this link: https://adamswebsearch2.nrc.gov/webSearch2/main.jsp?AccessionNumber=ML23297A078.

Finally, we note that, although there had been multiple FOIA requests for records relating to the Silkwood matter that the NRC processed years ago, and had made available to the public in the NRC's Public Document Room, due to record disposition schedules, they are no longer available.
