SUBJECT: ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF 10 CFR 34.101(c) NOTIFICATION LETTER

By letter dated January 24, 2025, and in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 34.101(c), you provided notification to this office that radiographic operations being conducted at temporary jobsites will exceed 180 days during calendar year 2025 at locations in Delaware, Montana and Alaska. Your notification letter was docketed under the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML25027A439 (a non-publicly available document), and the letter has been forwarded to the Materials Inspection Branch for inspection scheduling as appropriate. No further action from you regarding this notification is required with the following exception as described below.

Note that 10 CFR 34.3 defines a "field station" as a facility where licensed material may be stored or used and from which equipment is dispatched to other work locations. If the licensee plans to dispatch work from the locations in Delaware, Montana and Alaska, to other work locations, then these facilities will meet the definition of a "field station" and the licensee will need to submit an amendment request to the NRC license to authorize the locations in Delaware, Montana and Alaska, as field stations.
