The cover letter to the license amendment that you sent me said to call 630-829-9887 if there were any errors on the license, so I called and left a voice message. License items 9.T., 9.U., 9.V. should all say “**Same as Subitem No. 9.S.**” However, they currently say “Same as Subitem No. 9.U.” which was the correct before we removed the two irradiators.
