IN NRC-LICENSED ACTIVITIES (IA-18-040)

Dear Mr. Summers:

This letter acknowledges receipt of your letter post-marked January 21, 2025 (ML25028A195), providing notice of your acceptance, effective on January 6, 2025, of your first offer of employment in a position involving NRC-licensed activities following the prohibition period as required in Order IA-18-040. As required by the Order, your letter included the name, address, and telephone number of the employer where you are, or will be, involved in NRC-licensed activities.

In your letter, you also include a statement reinforcing your commitment to compliance with regulatory requirements and your assurance to do your utmost to comply with NRC's expectations in every respect as basis for why the Commission should have confidence that you will now comply with applicable NRC requirements.

Having satisfied all requirements in Order IA-18-040, no further action is required of you on this matter. However, you should be aware that your involvement in NRC-licensed activities may be subject to NRC inspection in the future.

Because this letter references and encloses information related to an enforcement action against an individual, this letter and its enclosures will be maintained by the Office of Enforcement in an NRC Privacy Act system of records, NRC-3, "Enforcement Actions Against Individuals." This system, which is not publicly accessible, includes all records pertaining to individuals who are being considered for, or have been considered for enforcement action, whether such action was taken or not.
