

10 CFR 20.1101(c) states that the licensee shall periodically (at least annually) review the radiation protection program content and implementation.

Contrary to the above, the licensee failed to periodically (at least annually) review the radiation protection program content and implementation. Specifically, the licensee performed a review of their radiation protection program content and implementation on December 6, 2022 and failed to perform one in 2023 and as of the inspection date on October 24, 2024.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Enforcement Policy 6.3)

The licensee stated that they will perform a review of their radiation protection program content and implementation by December 31, 2024 and to prevent recurrence the licensee will place this task onto their Microsoft Outlook calendar as a annually reminder.
