**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR CONFIRMATORY INFORMATION REGARDING HONEYWELL
METROPOLIS WORKS REQUEST TO RELAX CERTAIN ITEMS IN ATTACHMENT 1 TO ORDER EA-02-
025 - ENTERPRISE PROJECT IDENTIFICATION NUMBER L-2024-LLL-0018**

On March 25, 2002, the NRC issued Security Order EA 02-025 to Honeywell (Reference 2) that imposed certain security-related requirements in response to the then-current threat environment. Honeywell Metropolis (MTW) is requesting that a specific requirement in Attachment 1 Item #2 of the Security Order EA 02-025 be relaxed. MTW submitted the original request on September 9, 2024. A site visit was held with NRC personnel on December 3, 2024, and based on comments from the site visit, MTW developed and submitted a revision to the original letter on December 16, 2024. Honeywell MTW received a Request for Confirmatory Information (RCI) from the NRC on March 21, 2025. This letter is the MTW response to the RCIs.

The relaxation of a specific requirement in item #2 of Attachment 1 to the Order does not reduce the protection of the facility from a vehicle threat and will allow better traffic flow and potentially eliminate an employee safety hazard.
