Dear Licensing Reviewer,

I am writing to request that Saint Louis University NRC License No. 24-00196-07 (Docket No. 030-11789) be amended to add Kevin Ferguson as Radiation Safety Officer to our Type A Broad Scope Medical Use Materials License. We also request that Mark Haenchen be deleted as Radiation Safety Officer.

As Radiation Safety Officer, Mr. Ferguson is authorized by licensee management to perform duties and tasks in support of the following Authorized Uses.

1. For medical diagnosis, therapy, and research in humans in accordance with any applicable U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) requirements. This includes any 10CFR35.100, 35.200, 35.300, 35.400, 35.500 and 35.1000 byproduct material uses currently listed in Condition 6. of the license.
2. For research and development as defined in 10 CFR 30.4, including animal studies and in-vitro studies; instrument calibration; and student instruction. This includes any byproduct material currently listed in Condition 6. of the license.

Details of Mr. Ferguson's qualifications and experience were specified in the amendment request to add him as Associate Radiation Safety Officer in October of 2024. He is currently named on the NRC license, amendment number 52 as ARSO. His qualifications remain the same with a few months of additional experience.

As the Radiation Safety Officer for Saint Louis University and SSM Health Saint Louis University Hospital, you are responsible for:


- Managing the radiation protection program

- Initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions
- Verifying implementation of corrective actions
- Stopping unsafe activities
- Ensuring compliance with regulations

You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by individuals who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations, when justified, to maintain radiation safety. You are required to notify management if individuals do not cooperate and do not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time.
