Eastern Michigan University would like to place its program in standby status while we are without an authorized user. Eastern Michigan University has not made a final decision to permanently cease operations and considerations surrounding hiring qualified individuals are continuing. Eastern Michigan University has a Type B Broad Scope License with the NRC, license number 21-06885-01. We would like permission to store our radioactive materials securely until needed. Eastern Michigan University will adhere to all regulatory requirements for storage and security and conduct the program in accordance with NRC regulations and our license conditions. Eastern Michigan University will conduct a physical inventory every 6 months to account for all sealed sources and/or devices received and possessed under the license. I am the Radiation Safety Officer for the University and on our license. I will be the individual who will be responsible for maintaining control of the licensed material while it is in storage. Please let me know if you have any questions or need additional information to process the request. I appreciate your assistance in this matter.
