Dear Kelly Trice:

This letter refers to an investigation initiated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Office of Investigations (OI) on March 8, 2024, at the permanently shut down Indian Point Energy Center (IPEC) Units 1, 2, and 3. The investigation, which was completed on December 10, 2024, involved security matters that are considered sensitive information. Therefore, the details of the investigation are not included in this letter but are described in the non-public enclosures.

Based on the results of the investigation, the NRC determined that two violations of NRC requirements occurred. These violations were evaluated in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy and were assessed at Severity Level IV. The current Enforcement Policy is included on the NRC's website at <http://www.nrc.gov/about-nrc/regulatory/enforcement/enforce-pol.html>

After considering the factors set forth in Section 2.3.2.a of the Enforcement Policy, the violations are being cited in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). The details of the violations, including the assessment of their significance and the basis for citing the violations, are described with the results of the NRC OI investigation provided in Enclosure 1, and the Notice is provided as Enclosure 2. The NRC notes that Holtec Decommissioning International, LLC (HDI) took actions to address any security-related vulnerability.

Enclosures transmitted herewith contains sensitive unclassified non-safeguards information (SUNSI). When separated from enclosure, this transmittal document is decontrolled.
