By letter dated April 17, 2024 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Package Accession No. ML24108A007), as supplemented by letters dated February 20, 2025 (ML25051A253) and March 13, 2025 (ML25072A153), Constellation Energy Generation, LLC (Constellation) submitted an application for subsequent license renewal of Renewed Facility Operating License Nos.
