REPLOY Power submitted a letter of intent in July 2024 to engage in pre-application activities to the U.S. NRC. The initial regulatory engagement plan was submitted in September of 2024 (ML24270A051). REPLOY Power hereby submits **Revision 1** of the REPLOY Power Regulatory Engagement Plan. The enclosed regulatory engagement plan includes information on the principal design of the REPLOY Submerged Power System (SPS) as well as the regulatory strategy currently considered for successful deployment. The plan includes key design and licensing topics which REPLOY has identified as requiring effective pre-application interaction with the U.S. NRC to mitigate licensing risks. While the initial REP proposed a 3-phase approach, the revised plan outlines quarterly submissions for the next several years, with details as to the content of each planned submission

The REPLOY Power Regulatory Engagement Plan, Revision 1, contains information that is proprietary and confidential to REPLOY Power. As such we request that this submittal be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 2.390, as directed by the enclosed Affidavit.
