Dear Samantha Richards:

This is in reference to your letter dated February 26, 2025 notifying the NRC that Berkeley Medical Center (BMC) allowed Dr. Emil Cohen, a Yttrium-90 SIR-Sphere authorized user (AU) listed on another NRC license, to work as an AU in order to proctor your conditional AU, Dr. Vivek Padha. Thank you for providing this notification in accordance with your letter dated June 14, 2024. It is our understanding that Dr. Cohen has completed their work at BMC. In addition, you provided letter dated April 21, 2025 which confirms that Dr. Vivek Padha completed three hands-on patient cases supervised in the physical presence of a Yttrium-90 SIR-Spheres authorized user. Therefore, please find enclosed Amendment No. 38, which removes License Condition 12.B.:

"Physicians permitted to work as authorized users for Yttrium-90 SIR-Spheres in accordance with the notification commitments related to documentation of three proctored cases as required in the letter dated June 14, 2024. [ML24169A105]"

An environmental assessment for this action was not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14)

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license.
