On April 7, 2025, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted a hybrid meeting (virtual and in-person) concerning the Browns Ferry, Sequoyah, and Watts Bar Nuclear Plants. The purpose of this meeting was to provide an opportunity for the public to discuss the annual assessment of the plants for the period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024.

The meeting was held both virtually via Microsoft Teams and in-person at Athens State University / Sandridge Student Center, 300 N. Beaty Street, Athens, AL. Additionally, a dial-in by phone option was available.
