Substantial developments have occurred (and continue to occur) related to light-water reactor fuel, including supporting increased enrichment and accident tolerant fuels. In the rulemaking directed by SECY-21-0109, "Rulemaking Plan on Use of Increased Enrichment of Conventional and Accident Tolerant Fuel Designs for Light-Water Reactors," staff has engaged with all stakeholders regarding a path forward towards a more risk-informed approach for addressing address fuel fragmentation, relocation and dispersal at higher burnup levels than what is currently authorized.
