Dear Secretary Burgum:

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am providing the agency's status report as required by Section 5(c) of the January 20, 2025, Executive Order (EO) 14156, entitled "Declaring a National Energy Emergency." On March 13, 2025, in accordance with Section 5(a) of the EO, the NRC submitted our initial summary report listing planned or potential actions to facilitate the Nation's energy supply that may be subject to the Endangered Species Act (ESA) regulation on consultations during emergencies. Section 5(c) further directs the heads of all agencies to then submit a status report at least every 30 days for the duration of the national emergency following the submission of the initial summary report.

The NRC's status report is enclosed, reflecting the following changes since the last status report:


- The application for the H.B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant, Unit 2 (Duke Energy Progress, LLC), Subsequent License Renewal was accepted for review on April 28, 2025. The project has been bolded and moved from "Planned or Potential License Application Reviews" to "Current Licensing Reviews" for this monthly status update.
- The Section 7 ESA consultation for the project Point Beach Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2 (NextEra Energy Point Beach, LLC), Subsequent License Renewal was completed on April 29, 2025. The licensing action is still ongoing but, for the purposes of this report, the project has been removed from the list.
- The Section 7 ESA consultation for the project Clinton Power Station, Unit 1 (Constellation Energy Generation, LLC), License Renewal was completed on May 1, 2025. The licensing action is still ongoing but, for the purposes of this report, the project has been removed from the list.

The following projects were removed from the enclosed list of projects because the National Environmental Policy Act review has been completed. ESA consultation for these projects were completed in 2024.

- The Section 7 ESA consultation for the project Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 1 (Vistra Operations Company LLC) License Renewal was completed on September 11, 2024.
- No Section 7 ESA consultation for the project Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station, Unit 1 (Dominion Energy South Carolina), Subsequent License Renewal was required.

Per the direction in Section 5(c) of EO 14156, the NRC will continue to provide these status reports every 30 days for the duration of the declared national energy emergency.
