## Greetings Principal Chief Massey,

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff is issuing for public comment the draft Supplement 21, Second Renewal, to the Generic Environmental Impact Statement (GEIS) for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants, NUREG-1437, regarding the subsequent renewal of Renewed Facility Operating License No. DPR-33, DPR-52, and DPR-68, for an additional 20 years for the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant (Browns Ferry), Units 1, 2, and 3.

In April 2024, the NRC staff invited your office to participate in the environmental scoping process regarding this project (see letter at this link: <u>ML24106A264</u>). We are now inviting you to review and comment on the draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS).

The draft SEIS includes the preliminary analysis that evaluates the environmental impacts of the proposed action and alternatives to the proposed action. As discussed in the draft SEIS, the NRC staff's preliminary recommendation is that the adverse environmental impacts of the Browns Ferry subsequent license renewal are not so great that preserving the option for energy-planning decision-makers would be unreasonable. Additionally, the NRC staff has concluded that the proposed action—subsequent license renewal—would not adversely affect known historic properties or historic and cultural resources.
