**SUBJECT: C.T. RADIOLOGY COMPLEX, LLC, REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL
INFORMATION, MAIL CONTROL NO. 644843**

Dear Evelyn Patino Ortiz:

This is in reference to your letter dated January 16, 2025, requesting to amend NRC License No. 52-14931-01 and letter dated February 25, 2025, responding to our February 25, 2025. You have notified the agency of a merger between a NRC licensee and what we believe is a non-licensed entity. The NRC has determined that the transaction you described constitutes a change of control of the NRC license. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information. Please be aware that the requests below are taken from the guidance in NUREG-1556, Volume 15, Revision 1, “Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Guidance About Changes of Control and About Bankruptcy Involving Byproduct, Source, or Special Nuclear Materials Licenses” found at <https://www.nrc.gov/docs/ML1618/ML16181A003.pdf>. Licensees must provide full information and obtain NRC’s prior written consent before transferring control of the license. Please clearly state if any of the items are not applicable.

1. In a prior letter dated July 24, 2024, you stated that CT Radiology Complex & “MRI Institute” are both under the ownership or are legal entities of Bayamon Imaging and Interventional Institute, L.L.C. Please confirm that, following this transaction and merger with MRI Center, LLC, CT Radiology Complex, LLC, will still be under the ownership or a legal entity of Bayamon Imaging and Interventional Institute, L.L.C., noting the change in tax ID number.
2. Please provide an updated organizational chart for the surviving entity post-merger. Confirm that there are no planned changes in the organization, including but not limited to, transfer of stocks or assets and mergers, change in members on Board of Directors, etc.
3. Please confirm the correct spelling of the resulting licensee’s name: CT Radiology Complex, LLC (no periods between the letters, as noted in the application and letter dated February 25, 2025) or C.T. Radiology Complex, LLC (periods between letters, as noted on current license).
4. Information only, no response required – The proposed transaction has been removed from the public webpage. No responses were received.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at Jonathan.Pfingsten@nrc.gov.

In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter.

To do this, you must execute an affidavit as specified in 10 CFR 2.390. You must list all portions that you wish to be held proprietary, along with your reasoning as to why that is appropriate. While it is allowable, please refrain from submitting proprietary information in support of a license unless necessary. Keep in mind that all NRC licenses are considered to be in the public domain, and therefore may be viewed by any member of the public who requests to see them.
