Dear Stephen Subosits:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has received your submittal dated May 8, 2025 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System [ADAMS] Accession No. ML25128A132), requesting the review of the 2025 triennial update of the Decommissioning Funding Plan (DFP) for the Columbia Fuel Fabrication Facility (CFFF) in Hopkins, South Carolina.

We have completed our acceptance review of your submittal and have identified no administrative omissions or deficiencies that would prevent us from proceeding with a detailed review. Your submittal has been assigned Enterprise Project Identification Number (EPID) L-2025-DFA-0018. Please reference this EPID No. and Docket No. 70-1151 in any future correspondence associated with this request.

Please note that the NRC staff's technical review of your submittal may identify issues that require additional information. Based on our preliminary evaluation and projection of current review schedules, we anticipate completing our formal review by September 26, 2025. This schedule includes the issuance, if needed, of a request for additional information (RAI) by July 31, 2025, and receiving your adequate response to the RAI 30 days after you receive the draft RAI, unless another date is agreed upon. The schedule is based on the following assumptions: (1) RAI responses are timely and resolve issues with limited need for follow-up RAIs, and (2) clarification calls and audits, if needed, are scheduled and conducted promptly. Please note that these dates could change depending on the findings of our technical review, urgent assignments, or other factors. We will promptly communicate any significant changes to this schedule. In addition, the NRC staff estimates that completing the review of your submittal will require approximately 85 staff hours which corresponds to about \$27,455.00 (\$323.00/hr.). This staff hour estimation is at least 15 percent less than its last DFP update review for the CFFF.

In accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Section 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) or from the Publicly Available Records component of the NRC's ADAMS.
