SUBJECT: TELECONFERENCE SUMMARY BETWEEN THE U.S.
NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION, ILLINOIS STATE
HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE, AND CONSTELLATION
ENERGY GENERATION, LLC ON MAY 30, 2025 (DOCKET NO.
50-237 AND 50-249)

On May 30, 2025, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a teleconference meeting with staff from the Illinois State Historic Preservation Office (IL SHPO) and Constellation Energy Generation, LLC (CEG) to seek clarification on the eligibility recommendations on the draft architectural survey report submitted to the IL SHPO May 15, 2025 for the Dresden Nuclear Power Station (DNPS) Units 2 and 3 subsequent license renewal. CEG submitted its draft survey report to the IL SHPO on May 15, 2025, in compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended (CEG notified NRC by letter dated May 15, 2025, see Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) [ML25135A286](#)).

The meeting began with introductions, a discussion of applicable regulatory requirements and NRC and IL SHPO's comments based on a preliminary review of the draft survey report. The NRC staff then turned the discussion over to IL SHPO staff who proposed revising the architectural survey that : 1) provides additional information in order to determine the significance DNPS Unit 1 pursuant to the four criteria of eligibility at 36 CFR 60.4, 2) complete an evaluation of the DNPS' complex as a potential historic district that includes DNPS Units 1, 2 and 3, 3) provide a more thorough description regarding the integrity of each building, and 4) include a discussion of significance on the local, state, or national level.

At the conclusion of the meeting, the IL SHPO agreed to provide CEG a letter summarizing their comments on the approach to analysis and NRC management briefly clarified next steps on schedule and publication of the final subsequent environmental impact statement (IL SHPO letter dated June 10, 2025, see [ML25163A011](#)).
