This is in reference to your letter dated May 18, 2025, requesting to amend NRC License No. 06-02406-01 to remove an authorized user and to remove an authorized licensed material. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Regarding the removal of the authorized licensed material, please clarify:
 - a. Are you wanting to remove the authorization for any byproduct material permitted by 10 CFR 35.500 under your license? If so, please state this and acknowledge that the authorization will also be removed from the authorized users.
 - b. Are you wanting to replace the sealed sources for any byproduct material permitted by 10 CFR 35.500 under your license? If so, please submit the information for the new sealed source models you are requesting.
2. Regarding the disposal by Chase Environmental, Inc., please provide the documentation demonstrating the transfer of material.
