SUBJECT: ACRS ACTION ON REGULATORY GUIDES

During its 273rd meeting, January 6-8, 1983, the ACRS concurred in the Regulatory Position of Regulatory Guide 1.97, Revision 3, "Instrumentation for Light-Water-Cooled Nuclear Power Plants to Assess Plant and Environs Conditions During and Following An Accident". The ACRS wishes to be kept informed of the manner and details of implementation of this Guide, particularly with regard to the implementation schedule.

During this meeting, the ACRS considered also the proposed Regulatory Guide on Instrument Sensing Lines (Task No. IC 126-5), and decided to defer action on this Guide pending additional review by the ACRS Subcommittee on Reactor Operations.
