Good morning. I have reviewed your request dated June 4, 2025, to terminate U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Materials License No. 21-35407-01. Upon review, I identified the following areas in which additional information or clarification is needed:

1. Please provide a letter from the recipient of your Troxler Electronic Laboratories, Inc., Model 3430 portable gauging device, acknowledging receipt of the gauge into their inventory.
2. Please provide a current Leak Test Report for the Troxler Electronic Laboratories, Inc., Model 3430 portable gauging device. An acceptable report should reveal no evidence of leakage of radioactive material.
3. Our last inspection performed at your facility on May 22, 2023, identified that you only possessed a single Troxler Electronic Laboratories, Inc., Model 3430 portable gauging device, and that you had not acquired the IntroTek, Inc., Model 3500 portable gauging device that you are also licensed to possess. If applicable, please confirm that you only acquired the one portable gauging device. Otherwise, please provide appropriate documentation for the transfer/disposal and leak testing results for the IntroTek, Inc., Model 3500 portable gauging device.
4. Lastly, please confirm that there has been no history of any incidents involving licensed radioactive material at your facility, such as leaking or ruptured sealed sources, lost or missing radioactive materials or other incidents that may have threatened the containment of licensed radioactive material.

Please provide a written and signed response to this request within 15 calendar days, including a reference to U.S. NRC Materials License No. 21-35407-01 and Control No. 647190.
