Re: Notification of Hospital Closure and U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Materials License Amendment

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“NRC”) of the upcoming closure of St. Luke’s Des Peres Hospital (“Des Peres”) located at 2345 Dougherty Ferry Road, Saint Louis, MO 63122. Des Peres is scheduled to close on July 31, 2025 (the “Termination Date”).

Des Peres is an affiliate of St. Luke’s Hospital (“St. Luke’s”). Due to the Des Peres closure, St. Luke’s desires to amend its NRC Materials License, License No. 24-01570-03 (the “License”) to remove Des Peres as an address of use effective as of the Termination Date.
