Mr. Scott,

I am working on the license amendment for your specific NRC license. I also note that there are two additional requests submitted to our HQ staff for amending the exempt distribution license and the sealed source and device registration.

Your request for license 06-35731-01 includes the removal of an individual from license condition 12 and adding new devices to license condition 6-9. I was informed that the SSD will not be completed until early fall (approximately October) . With Connecticut becoming an agreement state (October 1), all our specific licensing actions need to be completed before September 1 to accommodate the file transition from the NRC to CT. This being the case, the SSD for the devices you requested will not have been approved in time for me to issue this amendment authorizing the new devices.

Here are the options that are available:

1. Process the amendment to remove the user from the license. The new devices will not be added.
 - a. Resubmit the amendment once the SSD gets approved. This would be submitted to CT for approval.
2. Request to withdraw the amendment. No changes made to the current license.
