SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING PROPRIETARY INFORMATION FROM
PUBLIC DISCLOSURE FOR RADIANT INDUSTRIES LLC'S PRESENTATION
TITLED: "RADIANT FACTORY SITING ASSESSMENT," FROM THE CLOSED
PORTION OF THE PUBLIC MEETING HELD ON APRIL 1, 2025

Dear Mr. Yang:

By letter dated April 1, 2025 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML25133A267), Radiant Industries, LLC (Radiant), submitted an affidavit to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff requesting that the information contained in the following document be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Section 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding:"

Radiant Factory Siting Assessment

The affidavit stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reasons:

- i. The information sought to be withheld from public disclosure is owned and has been held in confidence by Radiant and is not customarily disclosed to the public.
- ii. The information sought to be withheld is being transmitted to the Commission in confidence and, to Radiant's knowledge, is not available in public sources.
- iii. Public disclosure of this proprietary information is likely to cause substantial harm to the competitive position of Radiant because it would enhance the ability of competitors to gain a competitive advantage in the design, development, manufacture, installation, quality assurance, or licensing of similar products and services.
- iv. Additionally, this information was generated at significant labor and expense to Radiant and could cause competitors to infer planned commercial offerings like price, delivery, and service levels that Radiant intends to use.

Radiant has concluded that the document referenced above contains proprietary information throughout, for the reasons set forth in sections above.

The NRC staff has reviewed the affidavit and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, based on the statements in the affidavit, has determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure. In addition, the NRC staff has determined that the document contains proprietary information to an extent that a non-proprietary (i.e., redacted) version would be of no value to the public.

Therefore, the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Withholding from the public inspection will not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents. If the need arises, the NRC staff may send copies of the information to consultants working in this area. The NRC staff will ensure that the consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling proprietary information.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, Radiant should promptly notify the NRC staff. Radiant also should understand that the NRC staff may have cause to review this determination in the future if, for example, the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes Radiant information.

In all review situations, the NRC staff will follow applicable laws, regulations, and policies in conducting its review, including the NRC's policies on notifying the owner of information in advance of any public disclosure.
