Dear Carlos I. Rodriguez Ortiz:

This refers to your license amendment request dated May 6, 2025. Please find enclosed Amendment No. 24 removing Reinaldo Laguna-Figueroa, M.D. as an authorized user on your license. Please be aware that the removal of this user has led to a modification in your license authorized uses under 10 CFR 35.300. The authorization has changed from all uses permitted under 10 CFR 35.300 to the limited use of oral administration of sodium iodide iodine-131 under 10 CFR 35.300. Please also note some changes in the way your authorized use and user are listed. We have added '10 CFR 35.300' in front of (limited to oral administration of sodium iodide iodine-131) to match the current verbiage used on our licenses. This change is purely cosmetic and does not affect your authorization. Additionally, Condition 9.C. has been updated to specify that I-131 use permitted by 10 CFR 35.300 is limited to outpatient settings only, as per the provisions of 10 CFR 35.75. If you wish to include inpatient use in the future or remove authorization for 10 CFR 35.300 entirely, please submit an amendment request.

An environmental assessment for this action was not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. You will be periodically inspected by the NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action(s) against you. This could include issuance of a Notice of Violation, or Imposition of a Civil Penalty, or an Order Suspending, Modifying or Revoking Your License as specified in the NRC Enforcement Policy.
