**Subject:** Amendment Request for License No. 11-35248-01 — One-Time Extension to 15-Year Term

Dear Licensing Reviewer,

I am submitting this letter as a formal amendment request for NRC Materials License No. 11-35248-01 issued to Troy Curnutt Consulting, currently set to expire on **September 30, 2025**. In accordance with the NRC policy revision implemented on October 1, 2017, which extended the standard license duration from 10 years to 15 years, I respectfully request a **one-time, five-year extension** of the current license term.

**Justification:**

Troy Curnutt Consulting has maintained continuous compliance with all NRC rules and regulations and the specific conditions outlined in our license. We continue to:

- Safely store and use sealed sources of Cs-137, Ba-133, and Co-57 in accordance with the quantities, models, and purposes outlined in our application and license;
- Adhere to leak testing, inventory, and recordkeeping requirements as described in our approved radiation safety program;
- Employ qualified personnel, with myself (Vincent Troy Curnutt) continuing as the Radiation Safety Officer and the sole authorized user;
- Conduct operations at the same licensed address: 3003 Lois Lane, Pocatello, Idaho;
- Maintain an effective ALARA program and enforce robust safety procedures as documented in our previously submitted and approved radiation safety manual.

We believe that the continued adherence to these standards provides **reasonable assurance that public health and safety will be protected** throughout the extended license period.

Please consider this letter our formal request for an administrative amendment to extend the license expiration date from September 30, 2025, to September 30, 2030.
