Termination of NRC License No 21-08892-01 and Concurrent Transfer of Activities to License No. 21-01333-01

Dear Material License Reviewer:

Beaumont Health D/B/A Corewell Health - Southeast Michigan is in the process of centralizing radiation safety programs under broad scope license 21-01333-01. As such, we are requesting concurrently to transfer the Botsford General Hospital license 21-08892-01 that was being maintained separately by our same organization Beaumont Health D/B/A Corewell Health - Southeast Michigan (**NRC Form 314** is attached) while terminating the 21-08892-01 license. The services offered at the hospital locations will continue and their radiation safety programs will follow the commitments of the broad scope license, with all required records maintained. Their radiation safety programs are being moved to the same policies and procedures as License No. 21-01333-01, and day-to-day staffing remains the same. Because of this, a final radiation safety survey has not been conducted.

All required surveillance will continue, and current records have been documented and reviewed by NRC License No. 21-01333-01 radiation safety staff. Pursuant to 10 CFR 30.35(g), copies of drawings and records important to decommissioning will be transferred and maintained by NRC License No. 21-01333-01 radiation safety staff. **Please note that there is a current license action pending on this license, Mail Control number: 647227 dated June 9, 2025.**
