INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

<u>ACCEPTANCE</u>: Individuals listed in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the Inspection Procedures (G-108) Course. This course is scheduled to be presented September 22-26, 2025, at the Florida Bureau of Radiation Control Health Physics Lab. The Lab is located at 2100 All Childrens Way, Orland, FL 32818.

COURSE: Please note that the course begins at 8:00 a.m. eastern time on Monday, September 22nd, and ends at 12:00 p.m. eastern time on Friday, September 26th.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, September 21st, and depart on Friday, September 26th. If there are no flights available that would allow you to arrive home before midnight on Friday, you may elect to depart on Saturday, September 27th. In this event, NRC will provide reimbursement for hotel on Friday night and per diem on Saturday. Students need to make their lodging and air travel arrangements through El Sol Travel at (844) 244-6694 and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. If traveling by air, please contact El Sol Travel at (844) 244-6694 for airline reservations and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable government fare if one is available, and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your fare to the NRC. If the need arises and you must make a change, contact Karen Meyer at (301) 465-0791.

Please complete the Travel Information & Estimated Expenses Form which will be provided to you and submit to AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov, at your earliest opportunity, but no later than, Friday, September 12th. Individuals should request the Federal government rate at the hotels. The per diem for Orlando, FL is \$140 for hotel and \$80 for meals and incidentals. The first and last day of travel is calculated at 75 percent. Students are responsible for their own transportation between the hotel and the training center. If you are authorized to drive, the Federal mileage reimbursement is 70 cents per mile. Rental cars are not authorized for reimbursement.

If you live within 35 miles (one way) of the training facility, you will not receive per diem and lodging reimbursements.
