NRC Renews Perry Nuclear Power Plant Operating License

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has <u>renewed</u> the operating license of the Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 1, for an additional 20 years.

Perry Unit 1 is a boiling-water reactor in Perry, Ohio. Its license will now expire Nov. 7, 2046.

The NRC's review of the Energy Harbor application to authorize operations from 40 to 60 years proceeded on two tracks. A <u>safety evaluation report</u> was issued on May 29, 2025, and a <u>final supplemental environmental impact statement</u> was issued on April 30, 2025. These documents, as well as other information regarding the Perry license renewal application, are available on the NRC <u>website</u>, which also contains information about the license renewal process.
