This letter is regarding the response dated July 5, 2025, signed by Laura T. Speer Smith, M.S., Radiation Physicist, regarding the request for the renewal of your U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Materials License No. 21-32543-01.

The U.S. NRC's guidance document for your type of license, which I refer to below as "the guidance," is NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Rev. 3, dated September 2019, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Medical Use Licenses." This guidance is available on the U.S. NRC website at:

Upon review of the request, I identified the following areas requiring additional or clarifying information:

1. Section 8.13, "Item 13: Certification," specifies that a representative of the legal entity filing the application must sign and date the [NRC Form 313, "Application for Materials License."](#) The representative signing the application must be authorized to make binding commitments and to sign official documents on behalf of the applicant (i.e., a certifying official).

Laura T. Speer Smith, M.S., Radiation Physicist, signed the response letter regarding the license renewal. Though, her title is not recognized as that of a certifying official (i.e., President, Director or Hospital Administrator).

Therefore, please revise and submit the response letter bearing the signature of a certifying official. For additional information, you may refer to Chapter 3, "Management Responsibility," of the guidance.

2. Section 8.7.1, "Radiation Safety Officer," of the guidance, identifies that the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) is responsible for the oversight of licensed operations. The RSO must have sufficient organizational authority and management prerogative to enforce appropriate radiation protection rules, standards, and practices.

As previously requested, please submit an updated delegation of authority supporting your continuing appointment as RSO. Appendix I, "Radiation Safety Officer Duties, Responsibilities, and Delegation," of the guidance, includes an example delegation of authority on page I-4. Note that the delegation of authority should be signed by the RSO and a management representative. Include the printed name, title and date for each individual signing.

3. Section 8.7.1, "Radiation Safety Officer," of the guidance, includes a listing of typical duties and responsibilities of the appointed RSO. Among the listing of the typical duties and responsibilities of the RSO is interacting with the U.S. NRC. To facilitate such interactions and as previously requested, please provide applicable contact information for the appointed RSO, including all of the following, as applicable:

- office phone number;
- mobile phone number;
- fax number; and
- e-mail address.

In accordance with [10 CFR §2.390](#) of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC website at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

To continue review of your request, please submit your response to this letter within 10 calendar days from the date of this letter. In your response, please refer to the license, docket, and control number specified below. I will assume that you do not wish to further pursue this licensing action if I do not receive a reply within the specified timeframe noted above.
