SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE FOR HARBOR BEACH  
COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, U.S. NRC MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 21-32634-01

Dear Dr. Dubriwny:

The letters dated March 11, 2025 and August 5, 2025, signed by Ross Ramsey, M.D., President & CEO, Scheurer Hospital, and the accompanying NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," dated August 5, 2025, signed by Jill Wehner, President, notified the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of a request to terminate your U.S. NRC Materials License No. 21-32634-01.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required because this action is categorically excluded under [Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations \(CFR\) Section 51.22\(c\)](#).

The letters dated March 11, 2025 and August 5, 2025, provided sufficient information to permit the transfer of facilities at 210 South First St., Harbor Beach, Michigan, to another U.S. NRC Materials Licensee — SCHEURER HEALTHCARE NETWORK AND ITS SUBSIDIARIES SCHEURER HOSPITAL AND HARBOR BEACH COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, INC., U.S. NRC Materials License No. 21-32250-01. Based on my review, I have concluded that all licensable radioactive material at 210 South First St., Harbor Beach, Michigan, has been transferred from HARBOR BEACH COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, U.S. NRC Materials License No. 21-32634-01, to SCHEURER HEALTHCARE NETWORK AND ITS SUBSIDIARIES SCHEURER HOSPITAL AND HARBOR BEACH COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, INC., U.S. NRC Materials License No. 21-32250-01.

Based on this conclusion, no further remediation or actions with respect to U.S. NRC-regulated material are required on the part of HARBOR BEACH COMMUNITY HOSPITAL under this license. The U.S. NRC understands that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the 210 South First St., Harbor Beach, Michigan, facility have been transferred to and will be maintained by SCHEURER HEALTHCARE NETWORK AND ITS SUBSIDIARIES SCHEURER HOSPITAL AND HARBOR BEACH COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, INC., U.S. NRC Materials License No. 21-32250-01.

Accordingly, U.S. NRC Materials License No. 21-32634-01 is hereby terminated. A copy of the amended license—Amendment No. 8—is enclosed.
