I have spoken with the subject matter experts and we are in agreement that we do not want this new document to be part of the Materials License. This would be in agreement with how the DCS ISA (SP-3605-0053) was processed back in 2021. We will maintain our ISA documentation at the site for future inspection if needed. Please let me know if you need me to provide anything on the docket to remove this new SEC-25-0002 ISA from official approval. Or will NRC simply leave out of the approval letter and off of our Materials License like you did in 2011 for the SP-3605-0053?

Side Note: While reviewing our materials license to determine if SP-3605-0053 was part of our license, I noticed page SNM-2011, page 6 of 13 having an erroneous bb. listed for the last portion of the aa. reference.
