On behalf of Fermi America, we are submitting Revision 1 of Part 2 of the Combined License Application (COLA) for the President Donald J. Trump Advanced Energy and Intelligence Campus, Units 1 through 4, located in Carson County, Texas. This revision updates the previously submitted Part 2 – Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR).

In this revision, any areas where Fermi America site-specific information is still under development are clearly marked as **“TO BE PROVIDED LATER”** in red font for ease of identification. Fermi America is currently working with Westinghouse to complete a detailed gap analysis of these areas. We expect this gap analysis to be finalized by October 3, 2025. The missing sections will then be developed and submitted by the end of the first quarter of 2026.

This submittal may contain information that is proprietary to Westinghouse and, therefore, not suitable for public release. If requested, Fermi America will work with Westinghouse to prepare and provide a non-proprietary version of this revision for inclusion in the NRC’s public document system.
