To Whom It May Concern,

We are responding to your request for additional information, dated August 11, 2025. Please find the requested details provided below for your review. Your requests are listed below followed by our responses in red.

1. Item 7. Individuals Responsible for Radiation Safety – In your application, you requested the appointment of C. Kelly Stoneberg as the Associate Radiation Safety Officer (ARSO) for your license. Based on the documentation you submitted to support the appointment of this individual and the NRC’s knowledge of this person’s responsibility with other NRC licensees, it would appear that they would be considered a consultant ARSO for your license. Please provide the following information:

- a. Identify other commitments of the consultant ARSO for other NRC or Agreement State licensed facilities, along with a description of how the consultant ARSO will allocate time to permit the performance of the duties of the ARSO, as described in the regulations. State the consultant ARSO’s minimum amount of onsite time (hours per week or days per quarter, as appropriate for the size of the program).

Mr. Stoneberg provides Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) and Associate RSO (ARSO) services for other NRC and Agreement State radioactive materials (RAM) licenses. He will perform the required ARSO duties on-site and/or in-office as assigned by the

RSO. The time allocated for these duties is expected to average approximately eight hours per month, or as necessary to fulfill regulatory and operational requirements.

- b. Describe the overall availability of the consultant ARSO to respond to questions or operational issues that arise during the conduct of the radiation safety program and related regulatory requirements.

Mr. Stoneberg will be reachable by direct phone to address questions or operational issues arising from the radiation safety program and related regulatory requirements. He will also be available for virtual meetings (e.g., Teams, Zoom) and on-site presence as needed.

- c. If C. Kelly Stoneberg will be expected to respond to an event or an emergency, specify the maximum amount of time it will take the consultant ARSO to arrive at the facility, in the event of an emergency that requires his or her presence.

As the primary RSO is on-site daily, it is expected that Mr. Stoneberg's physical presence during an event or emergency will be rare. In the event that his on-site presence is required, Mr. Stoneberg will be able to arrive at the facility within four hours and will remain accessible by telephone during transit.
