

Per your email request dated 27 August, 2025, JRGO LLC. d/b/a Integrity Assessment Group Docket No. 030-38303 and Xcel Holdco LLC. Docket No. 030-39171 intend to merge companies effective as soon as 29 August, 2025. JRGO LLC d/b/a Integrity Assessment Group is considered the transferor and Xcel Holdco is considered the transferee per NUREG 1556 Volume 15. As a result of this transaction, there will be no changes to the management staff, procedures, licensed location(s), facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management as applied to the JRGO LLC. d/b/a Integrity Assessment Group radiation safety program.

The JRGO LLC. d/b/a Integrity Assessment Group and Xcel Holdco radiation protection programs currently in-place will continue to operate independent of one another at this time.

JRGO LLC. d/b/a Integrity Assessment Group has no current open inspection items however, the transferer is aware of its responsibility for possible resulting in enforcement actions.

Definitions:

Control: Control of a license is in the hands of the person or persons who are empowered

to decide when and how that license will be used. That control is to be found in the person

or persons who, because of ownership or authority explicitly delegated by the owners,

possess the power to determine corporate policy and, thus, the direction of the activities

under the license.

Transferee: A transferee is an entity that proposes to purchase or otherwise gain control of

an NRC-licensed operation.

Transferor: A transferor is an NRC licensee selling or otherwise giving up control of a

licensed operation.

Information Needed for Transfer of Control

Licensees must provide full information and obtain NRC's prior written consent before

Transferor JRGO LLC. d/b/a Integrity Assessment Group (Docket 030-38303) intends to merge with Transferee Xcel Hold Co LLC. (Docket 030-39171) effective 29 August, 2025. All current JRGO LLC. and Xcel Hold Co LLC. management staff will remain unchanged and continue to operate independently with respect to the radiation safety

and protection plans, procedures and practices. The license name, mailing address and contact name will remain the same.

2. Describe any changes in personnel or duties that relate to the licensed program. Include training and experience for new personnel and any changes in the training program.

At this time, there are no changes to personnel or duties as they relate to the radiation safety program. Training and experience for new personnel as well as the training program for new personnel and/or previously certified radiographers will remain unchanged.

Describe any changes in the location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program.

There will be no changes to the licensed location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the current licensed program.

4. Describe the status of the licensee's facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program, including any known contamination and whether decontamination will occur prior to transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.

The current licensee facility, equipment and radiation safety program are in working order with no known contamination. Personnel dosimetry calibrations are performed annually. Calibrated and operational personnel dosimetry is available for all radiographic personnel. Survey meters are calibrated at 90-day intervals and are currently available for use. Leak tests, area surveys, wipe test results, training and quality control records are available and maintained at the local level.

5. If current decommissioning funding plans (DFP) will be changed as a result of the transfer, the revised DFP should be submitted. If other financial assurance documents will be changed as a result of the transfer, confirm that all financial assurance instruments associated with the license will be held in the transferee's name before the license is transferred, and as required by 10 CFR 30.35(f), the licensee must, within 30 days, submit financial instruments reflecting such changes.

Decommissioning funding plans, financial assurance documents and instruments are not applicable to this transfer of control.

6. Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.

All records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee (Xcel Hold Co LLC.) or the NRC as appropriate. Including documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removeable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.

7. Confirm that both transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed

material and activity, and the conditions of transfer, and that the transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.

The transferor (JRGO LLC d/b/a Integrity Assessment Group and the transferee (Xcel Hold Co LLC.) agree to transfer control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of the transfer. The transferee has no current open inspection items however, the transferer is aware of its responsibility for possible resulting in enforcement actions.

8. Confirm that the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.

The transferee (Xcel Hold Co LLC.) will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor (JRGO LLC d/b/a Integrity Assessment Group), or will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.

9. The transferee, in the case of fuel cycle facilities, shall provide documentation showing that it is financially qualified to conduct normal operations. The information can be in the form of income statements and balance sheet forecasts.




Figure 1. New Organization Chart
